This is the sereasch, the effectiveness of criminal reporter groups: a cars study of Bangna police station using quantitative methodology. The objective of the servey is to assess in proceeding of the criminal reporter project, knowledge, attitude of the criminal reporter members to the police and to study the factors to the influence of project. The selected sample consists of 250 criminal reporter members by the simple sampling and using the questionnaires and analyzed by using SPSS/PC⁺ (statistical Package for Social Science Version PC⁺) Computer program. Statistical tools employed for data analysis were precentage, mean, standard deviation and Chi-Square at the .05 level of significance.

The result of this study showed that the criminal reporters projects running of Bangna police station in total and each one; such as, public relation, coordination, learning and training course running were in the little - high level. The training course running knowledge and taking to use include the attitude to the working of the police

were in the little - high level. As the effectiveness of the Criminal reporter members in total and each one; such as, criminal decreasing and the news effective increasing was in the little - high. The factors that effected to the effectiveness of this project were public relation, training course running, coordination, training course running knowledge and the attitude to the police working. For sex, age, education, occupation and income were not influency to effectiveness of the criminal reporter members project.
