The purpose of this research was to study the level of satisfaction of Mathayom 1 students at Wang KlaiKangWon School and Rajaprajanugroh Schools under the Royal Patronage on Distance Learning Instruction via satellite in four elements: contents of four subjects, personnels, classroom environment, teaching equipments and instructional media. The questionnaires were used to investigate the satisfaction of 303 students at Wang KlaiKangWon School and Rajaprajanugroh Schools under the Royal

Patronage on Distance Learning struction via satellite. Two hundred and sixty-seven responded which was 88.12 percent. The percentage, mean, standard deviation and frequency were used to analyze the data.

The findings this research indicated:

- 1. The contents of four subjects were found that the students were highly satisfied with science subject, Mathematics, Thai Language and English Language respectively.
- 2. Personnels were found that the students were highly satisfied with the teachers on television, teachers in the classroom, guest speakers and presenters in sequencely.
- 3. In the part of classroom environment was found that the students had the most satisfaction with the sufficient equipment provided at suitable time and places for learning process.
- 4. In the part of teaching equipments and instructional media were found that the students had the most satisfaction with the teaching method providing the photo or pictures appropriately.
