The objective of this natural therapy research is for truly understanding of natural therapy and their treatment by focusing on herb study which is developed for stress relieve (balance of body and mind), as well as focusing on stress people behavior especially at work since nowadays people are push under the pressure from work and economic situation which can effect on people's health and mind especially with people who work in downtown Bangkok.

This research found that herbal natural therapy can successfully achieve on stress relieve both for body and mind. Prai has mainly been studied because of their qualifications, for example their good scent can help on stress and muscle relieve. In addition, indigenous knowledge of Prai qualifies for stress relieve which has to been proceeded through complicated extract process. The result of the research has inspired to this project design. Project function analysis within working people can define project area into 3 sizes, S, M and L. Each size can approach to the therapy in working people group.

The result of Prai study especially on physical and internal extract process, and how to cut and dry of Prai has been explained into 3 separated function areas "Protect Transition Cure". The inspiration of the relationship between the result of Prai research and design (symbolic, meaning) has been shown in all elements of this project design (function, material, color and surface).
