The objectives of this research are twofold ; firstly, to study the motive of immigration police officers in Immigration Division 2 on carrying out their works; and secondly, to study the factors which are related to their motives .216 police officers in police Immigration Division 2 are the samples in this research.

The research findings are as follows:

1. The motives of immigration police officers in police immigration division 2 are at intermediate level.
2. As a whole, the only factor related to their motives is sex; that is, the motives of male are higher than female. Age, ranks, education level, workplaces, experiences and income are not related.

3. It is found that the direction of relationship are both consistent and inconsistent with the hypothesis. The relationship directions consistent with the hypothesis are the relation between ranks and the motives on advancement and administrative policy, the relation between sex and the motives on human relationship with their companions and working condition, and the relation between workplaces and the motives on working conditions. Those inconsistent with the hypothesis are the relation between income and the motive on system of command, the relation between educational levels and the motives on human relationship with their companies, salaries and fringe benefits, and the relation between workplaces and the motives on advancement and system of command.
