Abstract

The main objectives of this research were to study the faculty's income-expenditure and faculty affecting the income-expenditure. Furthermore this study analyzed the equal income and faculty expenditure in northern Thailand. The primary data was collected by survey forms, the study sampled 315 faculty who cover the area of Rajabhat institutes. The analysis of data was done and presented in terms of multiple regression and calculating the equal income expanding by finding out the gini coefficient.

The research result—showed that the gender, age and teaching period—had positive relation to the total income of faculty. In addition, male faculty had higher income than female faculty, an increase in age and teaching period will increase the total income of faculty.

In addition, the relationship between the household expenses and independent factors found that age, the number of family members and the total income related positive to the expenses. An increase in age, the number of family members and the total income will increase the household expenses. Furthermore, gini coefficient was 0.2205, which indicated that the income expenditure of faculty, in Rajabhat institutes in the north, provided equally.
