The purpose of this research was to evaluate the Pilot Project of Educational Extension Opportunity under the Jurisdiction of the office of the National Primary Education Commission in Nakomnayok Province by using a CIPP Model. The 522 samples in this research consisted of 38 administrators 144 teachers and 340 residents. The questionnaires with reliability of 0.7223, 0.8167 and 0.9201 respectively were constructed by the researcher and utilized as the tool for this research.

The results of this research showed that:

1. The desire in education of the parents residing in the area of the Opportunity Project under the Jurisdiction of the office of the National Primary Education Commission in Nakornnayok province was at a high level. The first priority of the community was for students to be given the opportunity to continue their education in the lower secondary level. The second priority was for students to develop work skills. The third priority was to have a lower secondary school in the community.

- 2. The readiness of personnel and education facilities were found to be insufficient. The buildings and teaching materials were in moderate appropriate.
- 3. The problems in teaching management and measurement and evaluation, in general, were at moderate level. The mostly occurred problems of the teaching management were the allocation of teachers according to their abilities and the school's management to supported students' and the community's needs. The problem in measurement and evaluation were the knowledge in item-analysis, test-construction and in adequate of materials.
- 4. The Educational Opportunity Project under the Jurisdiction of the office of the National Primary Education Commission in Nakornnayok province was considered to be successful.
