This study has mainly been conducted by a documentary research, observation research and a survey research as well. The findings are as follow:

- 1. Policies and Plans for flood prevention and resolution of Bangkok Metropolitan Administration (BMA) are more extensively clarified than those of Lat Phrao Administration Area (LPAA);
- 2. FLood Prevention and Resolution Performances of The BMA in Lat Phro Area are publicly considered as proper, effective, and moderately satisfied;
- 3. Effectiveness and Implementative Performances of Flood Prevention and Resolution Plans of the BMA, in terms of public evaluation, can be regarded in 2 distinctive categories:
- 3.1 The studied case communities of different backgrounds in socio economic statuses, show different evaluation in 5 different topics:

- 1) Construction and Maintenance of the community drainage system;
- 2) Maintenance of canals and streams;
- 3) Pumps setting for flood prevention and resolution;
- 4) Services for those effected by floods;
- 5) Satisfaction of flood prevention and resolution plans.
- 3.2 These concerned communities however have no different opinions in topics:
 - 1) General performances of the BMA;
 - 2) Construction of the flood preventives;
- 3) Public Relations of official Information about floods and flood prevention plans;
 - 4) Restoring the public utilities after flood damages.
