This study have 2 main objectives. Firstly, it-aims-at performance evalution, particularly of the Development Programs that-are responsible by Bangsue and Thoongsonghong police station, Secondly, the research-also-attempts to explain Development Program Performances by means of statistical analysis.

Based on a survey research, the study has essentially found that the performances of both Bangsue and Thoongsonghong police station, in terms of Development Programs, can be ranged at the middle-level of the statistically measured-scale.

Gender,-age-levels, educational levels-and occupations have no statistical difference to Developmente Program Performances of the above-mentioned police station.

However, marital status-and income levels have statistical significances to General Services-and Public Relations of those Police Stations.
