The research results revealed the there are 50 members in sub-District Organization Committee, Bangnampreaw District, Chacheangsao Province. Most of them are male, between 31-40 years old, married. The income is between 3,001-6,000 Baht per month, and earn the living as agriculturists. They have high level of understanding in their duties and responsibilities as well as high level of participation in development tasks of the community.

Knowledge and understanding in the duties to develop community of Sub-District Organization Committee, Bangnampreaw District, Chacheangsao Province has no direct relationship with participation in developing community.

The members of Sub-district Organization Committee who are married have higher level of participation in developing community than the single members. And the members who do personal business have higher level of participation in the work than the members who earn the living as agriculturists, merchants, and employees respectively.
