

## ABSTRACT

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The objectives of this research were to : 1) study the opinions of teacher of private higher institutions in Bangkok Metropolis towards curriculum, particularly the objective, structures, and contents of the curriculum, teaching and learning and criterion of evaluation and measurement 2) propose the ways in the development and implementation of that curriculum in private higher institutions in Bangkok Metropolis. Utilizing the simple random sampling technique, 2,090 of the 3,948 teacher in 14 private higher institutions in Bangkok Metropolis had been sampled according to the criterion set by Krejcie and Morgan. The instrument of the study was the check-list and Rating scale questionnaire which had a reliability of 0.95 Analysis of the data were carried out to find percentage, arithmetic mean and standard deviation.

The result of the study revealed that private university teachers viewed their curriculum, particularly the objectives, structures, contents of the curriculum,

teaching and learning, and measurement and evaluation as highly appropriate.
