The finding from the study concluded that most students have moderate level of knowledge and understanding. According to the research hypotheses, it is found that students with different genders have different level of knowledge and understanding in the forms and contents of democracy in Thailand. This can be identified in statistical significance level at 0.05. Females have more knowledge and understanding than male. Students with different educational level have different level of knowledge and understanding in the forms and content of democracy in Thailand, which can be identified in statistical significance level at 0.05. Students studying in Matthayom 3 have higher knowledge and understanding than students of Matthayom 1 Students studying in schools located in different areas do not have different level of knowledge and understanding in the forms and contents of democracy in Thailand, Students residing in different areas also do not have different level of knowledge and understanding in the forms and contents of democracy in Thailand.
