The purposes of this research were to study the administrative behaviours of the Air Technical Training School administrators, and job satisfaction of the teachers and officials in the Air Technical Training School.

The sample comprised 225 teachers and officials of the Air Technical Training School, Directorate of Education and Training, RTAF, The research instruments for data collection were a Leader Behavior Description Questionnaire which consisted of leader behaviors in relationship concentration and job concentration, and a job satisfaction assessment questionnaire.

The results revealed that:

- 1. the administrators' administrative behaviours in relationship concentration and job concentration were in a moderate level,
 - 2. the teachers' and officials' job satisfaction was in a moderate level
- 3. the administrators' administrative behaviours and the teachers' and officials' job satisfaction were positively interrelated.
