The purpose of this research is to study the telecommunication development master plan, especially the privatization policy of the Communication Authority of Thailand. The research is also to study roles of the State Enterprise Employees Association of the Communication Authority of Thailand (SEA-CAT) toward the telecommunication master plan.

The research findings are as follows ; the SEA-CAT supports the telecommunication master plan but opposes the privatization method that separate the post office out of telecommunication office and various conditions which might effect career stability of the employees. The controversial matter had been negotiated and compromised between the SEA-CAT's representatives and The Communication deputy minister. The SEA-CAT also used a demonstration against the matter. After the SEA-CAT's roles toward the matter, the government accepted it's demands for reconsideration. However, after this issue got into the cabinet meeting's agenda, all the SEA-CAT's demands were dismissed.
