

ABSTRACT

Thesis Title : Governmental Organization's Leadership :
A case study of the Governance of the
office of Rajabhat Institutes Council

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The purpose of this research is to study levels 1-6 officials's opinions concerning the leadership of level 7 heads of divisions of the Office of Rajabhat Institutes Council.

The research findings are as follows :

1. Most of the levels 1-6 officials agree that leadership of level 7 heads of divisions is a combination

of consultative and benevolent authoritative styles.

2. There is statistically significant relationship at 0.05 level between each of these levels 1-6 officials' backgrounds, i.e., rank, educational level, and time period of present position and their opinions about leadership style of level 7 heads of divisions.

3. There is no statistically significant relationship at 0.05 level between each of the following backgrounds, i.e., sex, age, salary and years of work and the opinions about leadership style of the level 7 heads of divisions.
