The purpose of this research is to study levels 1-6 officials's opinions concerning the leadership of level 7 heads of divisions of the Office of Rajabhat Institutes Council.

The research findings are as follows:

1. Most of the levels 1-6 officials agree that leadership of level 7 heads of divisions is a combination

of consultative and benevolent authoritative styles.

- 2. There is statistically significant relationship at 0.05 level between each of these levels 1-6 officials' backgrounds, i, e., rank, educational level, and time period of present position and their opinions about leadership style of level 7 heads of divisions.
- 3. There is no statistically significant relation-ship at 0.05 level between each of the following backgrounds, i.e., sex, age, salary and years of work and the opinions about leadership style of the level 7 heads of divisions.
