## **ABSTRACT**

The purposes of this research were 1) To construct a Thai Module Lesson on "The Thai Sentences" for Mattayomsuksa 2 students. 2) To compare the students' learning achievement between pretest and posttest scores. 3) To study the student' attitude toward of the use of Thai Module lesson. From 13 classes, one class- 40 students - was selected by simple random sampling.

The researcher instrument used included three module lessons, along with the supplementary documents, the pre-and-post achievement test on the module lessons, and a questionnaire on attitude towards the use of module lessons.

The statistical procedures employed were the Thai Module Lesson's efficiency analysis based on the 80/80 standard, t-test analysis for the comparison of the students' learning achievement between pretest and posttest scores through the module lessons, and mean  $(\overline{X})$  for the students' attitude toward the module lessons.

The major findings were 1) The Thai Module Lesson's efficiency was 85.566/80.125 2) The students' posttest scores were higher than the pretest scores at the statistical level of 0.05 significant difference. 3) Most students had good attitude towards the module lessons.
