The purpose of this study was to study the organizing of the environmental education of 35 organizations which were registered for Environmental Education Act during 1992-1997. The sample was composed of organizing administrators and 35 organizers. The 70 questionnaires were collected by the researcher and sent by mail. Sixty-four questionnaires or 91.4 percents were returned. The data were then analyzed in terms of percentage, mean and standard deviations.

The results were as follows:

- 1. The objectives of the organizing the environmental education activities were mostly emphasised on knowledge, participation and awareness in environment.
- 2. The environmental education content were mostly emphasised on forestry development and wild animals development.
- 3. The organizing in environmental education activities was mostly emphasised on training activities using lecture, opinion expressions and group process respectively.
- 4. Teaching materials were pictures, slides, slide tapes and video tapes on environmental education.
  - 5. Observation on students' participation was mostly used in measurement and evaluation.
- 6. The budgets were found to be the most important problem in organizing the environmental education activities on non-governmental organizations.
