The purpose of this study was to study the organizing of the environmental education of 35 organizations which were registered for Environmental Education Act during 1992-1997. The sample was composed of organizing administrators and 35 organizers. The 70 questionnaires were collected by the researcher and sent by mail. Sixty-four questionnaires or 91.4 percents were returned. The data were then analyzed in terms of percentage, mean and standard deviations.

The results were as follows :

1. The objectives of the organizing the environmental education activities were mostly emphasised on knowledge, participation and awareness in environment.
2. The environmental education content were mostly emphasised on forestry development and wild animals development.
3. The organizing in environmental education activities was mostly emphasised on training activities using lecture, opinion expressions and group process respectively.
4. Teaching materials were pictures, slides, slide tapes and video tapes on environmental education.
5. Observation on students' participation was mostly used in measurement and evaluation.
6. The budgets were found to be the most important problem in organizing the environmental education activities on non-governmental organizations.
