

ABSTRACT

Thesis : Adminnistrative Development Role of Local Leaders
: A Case Study of Kalasin Province.

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The main objective of this study is to study adminnistrative development role of local leaders. The population of this study were 217 local leaders selected from thirteen districs and two subdistricts in Kalasin Province. The purpose of this research were to study the adminnistrative development role and to search for factors affecting the role of local leaders. And also to exammine relevant problems of the role.

The selected factors for studying were social and economic backgrounds , leadership , external communication with peoples and organizations outside the leaders ' villages. The data was conducted by using questionnaires. The collected data was processed by computer using ststistical package for the social science (SPSS/PC+). The statistical tests applied in data analysis were frequency

distribution , percentage and chi-square technique. The research findings were as follows :

1. The social and economic backgrounds did not have significant relationship with administrative development role of local leaders.
2. There were significant relationships between the leadership and administrative development role of local leaders.
3. The external communication did not have significant relationships with administrative development role of local leaders.

According to the local leaders' views , the problems of administrative development role of local leaders are as follows :

1. Lack of budget.
2. Misunderstanding of people about administrative development role of local leaders .
3. Inadequate knowledges and understanding of local leaders about their role.

Some suggestions for local leaders about their administrative development role are as follow :

1. There should be an extension program for local leaders training.
2. Benefits and welfare for local learders should be increased.
3. Budget and relevant equipments should be more supported than before.
