

ABSTRACT

The objectives of this research was to study job satisfaction of social workers in the Bangkok Metropolitan Administration. The population of 168 social workers in Bangkok Metropolitan Administration was used in this study. Questionnaires were used as instrument for data collection. Some relevent statistics such as frequencies, percentages, means, and chi-square test were applied in data analysis.

The research findings were as follows :

1. The majority of social workers were highly satisfied of their work as well as inter-personal relations among colleagues, and with career advancement. Moreover, they were moderately satisfied with inter-personal relations with superiors and working conditions. Most social workers were satisfied only at a low degree with salary and benefits received.

2. There was statistically significant relationship at 0.05 level between social workers' job satisfaction concerning some dimensions of working environment and their background such as age, working experience and number of dependants.
