The Method of selecting judges is a precise procedure which various civilized nations are attempting to scrutinize in order to recruit judges with a wide range of knowledge in various fields of science, not only in the field of law. The ideal judge must also have integrity, virtue and heartfelt sense of justice.

This study has determined that the initial level of recruitment of court of first instance judges in almost every system is primarily the duty of executive organizations to proceed with the recruitment and build the mechanism or method by which to analyze and coordinate with the other branch of government. The important objective is to ensure that the recruitment of judges is autonomous without coming under the control or interference of any other authority. Be that as it may, the method for

recruitment of judges may not be the only method, it must also include training and practice under the supervision of senior judges for an extended period.

It is not yet possible to pronounce the best method to recruit judges out of the various methods for recruitment of the diverse countries, the reason is because there is no formula by which to equate or measure the quality of judges in each country which is as accurate as a scientific method. It is, however, possible to mention that the all various methods create mechanisms and procedures by which to recruit judges which are autonomous without coming under the control or interference of any other authority so as to be able to appropriately protect the rights and freedoms of the citizenry and the judiciary and also ensure that it is in accord with the political, governmental, social, and cultural systems of each individual country.
