

Abstract

TETRACYCLINE SYRUP AND TOPICAL STEROID THERAPY FOR RECURRENT APHTHOUS ULCERS

The research of the recurrent aphthous ulcers, occurred at least one year and every 1-3 months, was studied by comparison of drug therapy in two groups for 80 adult peoples of 16 years old and over.

Group 1 Tetracycline syrup and vitamin B complex tablets
 for 2 weeks.

Group 2 Tetracycline syrup, vitamin B complex tablets and
 topical steroid kenalog for 2 weeks.

By χ^2 test there is no significant difference in drug therapy during 7 days. But drug therapy continue long than 7 days efficiency of therapy gr II better than er I = 3.77.
