ABSTRACT

The purposes of this investigation were to evaluate and study problems on work performance, and to study opinions concerning improvement of work performance of the Provincial General Education Offices in Education Region 9

The sample was comprised of 533 subjects including 113 officials working in the Provincial General Education Offices, and 420 secondary school administrators. The instrument was a set of questionnaires. The earned data were analysed by a computer program to calculate percentage, arithmetic mean, and standard deviation.

Findings :

The respondents perceived that the Provincial General Education Offices performed the operation at the "above average" level were personnel, planning and budgeting, academic, financial, materials, school plant and general administration, whereas operation on training was performed at the "under average" level. Problems on the operation at the "above average" level were general administration, academic training personnel, planning and budgeting, and personnel administration. Problems concerning financial, materials, and school plant administration were at the "under average" level.

Needs for work performance improvement were setting of appropriate working patterns, organizing good-conditioned office, allocating proper annual budget, selecting personnel with high competencies and adequate numbers, developing personnel competencies, collecting accurate educational data, and providing training for instructional development.
