ABSTRACT

The purposes of this study were to; (1) study curriculum implementation problems in Mathayom Suksa I, (2) investigate the opinions of curriculum implementation. The sample consisted of 712 subjects. They were; 307 heads of Education offices, educational suppervisors, school aministrators, and teachers; 270 students and 135 parents. The data were collected by the use of survey forms and questionnaire. The data were statistically analyzed by using the SPSS/PC+ computer program to find percentages, arithmetic means and standard deviations.

Findings:

1) The result indicated that there was no problem about classrooms and buildings. But the schools mostly faced problems related to teaching materials. And also the primary schools could not provide sufficient elective courses according to students' needs and interests.

- 2) The opinions related to curriculum implementation showed that there were not enough teachers in schools. The school teachers had to teach both in elementary and secondary levels. There was not sufficient teaching media. And the shortage of curriculum materials and the unsuitable of desks and equipments to ages of students were also found.
- 3) It was found that the parents wanted their children to receive short course vocational training in schools. The motivation for sending children to school was that they did not have to pay tution fee.
