	Based on Schiffrin 's definition (1987), 81 discourse markers are identified. This
	can be classified into five groups according to their primary function in one of the five
	components of discourse.
i	1. There are 22 discourse markers which function in the ideational structure,
	displaying cohesion and information structuring.
	2. There are 17 discourse markers which function in the action structure,
	displaying the speaker's intention.
	3. There are 7 discourse markers which function in the exchange structure,
	displaying turn management in conversation.
	4. There are 29 discourse markers which function in the participation framework
	displaying the speaker's role and interpersonal relationship between participants.
