

The objectives of this thesis are to study the viewpoints of library administrators and librarians at Rajamankala Institute of Technology (RIT) on Standards for Vocational and Technological Libraries 1992 edition with focusing on the use and non-use of the Standards; and to compare the RIT libraries with the quantitative Standards.

The hypotheses are that the majority of library administrators and librarians view that the qualitative Standards are suitable but the quantitative Standards are not. Both groups use standards as a guideline and criteria for developing resources and improving services. RIT libraries are below these Standards.

The survey research method was employed. A questionnaire was distributed to 41 library administrators and 40 librarians in RIT libraries. The return rate of the questionnaire was 76.54 percent.

The research result showed that library administrators and librarians viewed that both qualitative and quantitative Standards were suitable. Standards was used as a guideline for administrators on library support and development. The RIT libraries were quantitatively below the Standards.
