#### Abstract

The purpose of this study was to construct the virtue observation forms concerning enthusiasm, discipline, patience, and punctuality. The virtue observation forms were constructed as behavioral observation forms, indicating the students' virtue. Each behavior was brought from those teachers who taught virtue given by choosing the activities that students often practiced. In the virtue observation forms, there were 30 behaviors in enthusiasm, 38 behaviors in discipline, 30 behaviors in patience and 34 behaviors in punctuality. The sample of this study was the students in Prathom Suksa 5 in the second semester of 1996. This sample had got by the multi-stage sampling through 100 students, under the Bureau of the Private Schools Committee in Muang District, Chiang Mai Province.

The findings were as follows :

1. There was construct validity of the 4 virtue observation forms.
2. There was concurrent validity of the 4 virtue observation forms, studied by known group technique.
3. The reliability of the 4 virtue observation forms were so high. The reliability of enthusiasm, discipline, patience and puntuality were 0.9897, 0.9898, 0.9891 and 0.9976 in order.
