ABSTRACT

The purpose of this study was a survey research to examine the relationship between needs for self development and future orientation of physical education teachers in the secondary schools under the jurisdiction of the general education department khon kaen. The tools used in this study consisted of Pajonsug Kajohnsilp's needs for self development in physical education teaching a questionnaire (B.E. 2534) and the researcher do one, with reliability value of .96 and Boonrub Sakmanee's future orientation questionnaire (B.E. 2532) with reliability value of .65. The sample consisted of 164 physical education teachers in

secondary schools under the jurisdiction of the general education department khon kaen. The statistics used included the percent, mean, standard deviation and Pearson Product Moment Correlation.

The result showed that:

- 1. Needs for self development and future orientation of physical education teachers in the secondary schools under the jurisdiction of the general education department khon kaen showed a positive relationship, significant at the .001 (r = .31)
- 2. Needs for self development of physical education teachers in the secondary schools under the jurisdiction of the general education department khon kaen were high level.
- 3. Future orientation of physical education teachers in the secondary schools under the jurisdiction of the general education department khon kaen was high level.
