ABSTRACT

The purposes of this research were 1) to examine the opinions of primary school administrators concerning work practices of the District Primary Education Offices in Sakonnakhon province in the following aspects: general administration, personnel administration, finance and materials, and educational supervision, 2) to find ways to develop the practices.

The sample subjects consisted of 242 primary school administrators. A set of questionnaires was employed to collect data. The earned data were then analysed by a programmed computer to acquire frequencies, percentages, means, and standard deviations, and ranking.

1. The primary school administrators perceived that District
Primary Education Offices had fulfilled their work at the "above
average "level in all four aspects: general administration, personnel
administration, finance and materials, and educational supervision.
      Furthermore, the sample subjects also stated that the District
Primary Education Offices had "little" problem in all four aspects.
      2. The directions to advance the practices recommended
consecutively by the respondents were:
           2.1 In general administration: office arrangement, physical
plants, and facility should be improved in order to assist work;

2.2 In personnel administration : man power in schools should be planned comparing with the government teachers commission standard;

2.3 In finance and materials : financial arrangement should

be well organized in accordance with the government regulation;

2.4 In educational supervision : student learning and activities should be followed up.
