This study is the case study of three students who had drug addiction and got treatment in the drug rehabilitation center of Naresuan Military Camp hospital, Phitsanuloke province. The purpose of the study focuses on the cause of drug addiction of three students and the assistance of giving up drugs by using psychological process together with treatment by the hospital, including monitoring of student behavior after stopping drugs.

The study case was three drug addicted students who got treatment in the drug - rehabilitation center of Naresuan Maharach Military Camp hospital, Phitsanuloke province.

Research tools for data collecting are as follows: observation and record, interview, home visit, autobiography, daity record, comutative record, questionnaires and test forms. The study was conducted in 16 July 1997 - 16 January 1998. Date analysis, problem consideration, assistance planning, monitoring of study case was implemented by case conference.

As a result of the study, it was found that drug addiction of three students were caused by many reasons: family condition: guardians or parents lack of time to take care of their children's behavior closely, they were busy with earning a living; student personality: no self - confidence, sensitive, lack of reason and emotional maturity, following their friends and tending to environment.
