This thesis intends to study the consistency between the voters' political discourse on members of the parliament and the political discourse on politicians that entails the victory over the election of the politicians. The study of discourse in this thesis is undertaken in a Foucauldian framework.

The scope of the study is confined within the comparison between the political discourses of the voters of two constituencies, namely Pasricharoen and Suanluang.

After undertaking the research, it is found that in Pasicharoen and Suanluang, the voters have different discourses as regards members of the parliament. The politicians who offer political discourses consistent with the voters' political discourses on members of the parliament is prone to be elected.
