

This research is aimed at studying and comparing a public policy formulation of the Thai government with emphasis on the governments headed by elected prime ministers. In this research the Chatichai Chunhawan and Chuan Leekpai governments will be used as case studies. This study assumes that the Chatichai Chunhawan government formulates its own policy rather than take advices from the bureaucrats while the Chuan Leekpai government formulates public policy mostly in accordance with suggestion of the bureaucrats. This study also assumes that political parties have minimal roles in influencing the government to implement the party's policies.


The methods employed in this study are descriptive analysis of relevant documents. In doing so, the public policy formulation of the governments in the United Kingdom are used as a model in examining whether the formulation of the administrative policy is influenced by the bureaucrats, and whether each government has a proper role in implementing its stated policies to achieve its pre-set goals. The study also analyses processes of dividing duties between bureaucrats and politicians, and the roles which the bureaucrats should play in implementing the government policy.

The study finds that the above assumptions are true.
