The purpose of this research was to compare the marital satisfaction
in the married couple with similar and dissimilar personality traits.

The results show as follows :

1. Married couple who both scored high in the following factors would
have the highest marital satisfaction

- Out - going (I = 3.97)
- Dominande or Ascendance (I = 3.88)
- Conscientious (I = 4.15)
- Venturesome (I = 4.14)
- Experimenting (I = 3.97)

2. Married couple who both scored low in the following factors would
have the highest marital satisfaction

- Intelligence (I = 3.94)
- Happy-go-lucky (I = 4.03)
- Suspicious (I = 3.99)
- Apprehensive (I = 4.21)
- Shrewd (I = 3.91)
- Controlled (I = 3.98)
- Self-Sufficiency (I = 3.96)
- Tensed (I = 4.09)

3. Married couple who one scored high while the other scored low in
the following factors would have the highest marital satisfaction

- Tender-minded (I = 3.89)
