The purpose of this research was to compare the marital satisfaction in the married couple with similar and dissimilar personality traits.

The rusults show as follows:

- 1. Married couple who both scored high in the following factors would have the highest marital satisfaction
  - Out going (I = 3.97) Dominande or Ascendance (I = 3.88)
  - Conscientious (I = 4.15) Venturesome (I = 4.14)
  - Experimenting (I = 3.97)
- 2. Married couple who both scored low in the following factors would have the highest marital satisfaction
  - Intelligence (I = 3.94) Happy-go-lucky (I = 4.03)
  - Suspicious (I = 3.99) Apprehensive (I = 4.21)
  - Shrewd (I = 3.91) Controlled (I = 3.98)
  - Self-Sufficience (I = 3.96) Tensed (I = 4.09)
- 3. Married couple who one scored high while the other scored low in the following factors would have the highest marital satisfaction
  - Tender-minded (1 = 3.89)
