## Abstract

The purposes of the study were to compare the result of data collecting and the coorperation in giving the answers by using the questionaire and being interviewed from supervisors in Chiang Mai's office of Primary Education. The population of this was grouped in 1) the group got the questionnaire amounted 39 persons and 2) the group was interviewed amouted 35 persons. Purposive sampling from the group coorperating in giving the answers was used for comparing the result of the data collecting from the group got the questionnaire amounted 35 persons and the group was interviewed amounted 35 persons. It was found that.

- 1. The coorperation in giving the answers of the Supervisors by using the questionnaire and interviewing was statistically nonsignificant at .05 level.
- 2. The data collected by interviewing could give more the details and the cleaness than using the questionnaire; statistically significant at .01 and .05 level.
