The objectives of this research are to explore the discretionary powers of the Department of Local Administration's inspectors and to propose relevant recommendations in order to improve the efficiency of the inspection domain of the Department.

Since the priority activity of a local inspector is the assessment of the effectiveness of the implementation of public policies, he has an extensive opportunity to use the discretionary powers in the execution of their duties. However, the inspectors are restrained from using their powers by a number of factors, namely, the stability and security of their own career, the interests of their peers in the Department. Notwithstanding, the tasks of the local inspectors are essential in assessing the job performance of officials. It is recommended that an agency should undertake the responsibility of supporting and improving the efficiency of the work of the inspectors.
