: Comparative Levels of Cognitive

Image Toward State and Power of

State: A Case Study of Grade 6 Students in Phayao Province.

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Abstract

The continuity of a nationhood requires effective processes of political socialization which generate "cognitive image" of the terms of "State" and "State Power". This cognitive image can either be "positive" or "negative" orientations. If the result of political socialization indicates "negative" effects, the survival of that nationhood would be in critical stage of disintegration.

This study had 2 main objectives which are:

1. to compare cognitive image on "State" and "State Power" of Grade 6 students from 2 schools of different locality, situated in Amphoe Muang while another one situated in a remote Amphoe of Phayao Province. The purpose of this comparison is to

- examine whether the proximity and the distance of the schools affect the levels of cognitive image or not.
- 2. to learn about the correlations between factors which influence "cognitive image" of Grade 6 students in Phayao Province.

The samples for this study are 240 students who are studying in Grade 6 from 2 schools of different locality in Phayao Province. The samples are selected by the techniques of "purposive sampling" and "stratified random sampling".

Data are collected by using questionaires and statistical analysis of percentage, T-test and correlation coefficient by setting statistical means at 0.05.

The study's finddings can by summarized as follow:

1. the hypotheses number 1 to 3 are found to be untrue.

- 2. sex is a high influencing factor on cognitive image.
- 3. there is no difference in level of cognitive image
