The purposes of this reserch were to study three factors related to continuing and discontinuing of students in Dramatic Arts Colleges: student themselves, socioeconomy and institution environment including comparisions of the factors related for both groups. In collecting data, questionnaires were employed to 567 students and 10 college administrators were interviewed. Means, Standard deviation, t-test, factor analysis and content analysis were used in data analysis.

The finding of the reserch revealed that


1. The related factors of continuing and discontinuing of student were student themselves, socioeconomy and institution environment which consist of components as follows: peer group relationship, skill in thai classical dance and music, continuing study at other institutions with peer group, family support and costs of studying, undesirable in thai classical dance and music, confidence in employment.



Variable comparisions of all factors related to continuing and discontinuing of student at Dramatic Arts Colleges with statistical significant differences level at 0.01 revealed that factors related to continue studying were skill in thai classical dance and music, family support and costs of studying, confidence in employment, peer group relationship. Factors affected discontinuing of study were undesirable in thai classical dance and music, continuing study at other institutions with peer group.
