The purposes of this research were to study and compare habits and attitudes towards learning, and attitudes towards profession of physical education college students in Bangkok Metropolis and in the other provinces. The tools of this study were the Sujit Sirirat's Habits and Attitudes Towards Learning inventory and the Attitudes Towards Profession of Physical Education inventory designed by the researcher. The total populations of 326 were male and female freshman students with physical education major from the government universities. The collected data were then, analyzed in terms of means, standard deviations and the t-test was also applied to test the significant differences.

The results were as follows :

1. The habits towards learning aspects of time management and work method were at the fair level.
2. The attitudes towards learning in the teacher approval aspect were at the fair level but in the education acceptance aspect were at the good level.
3. The attitudes towards profession of physical education were at the good level.
4. In comparison of the habits towards learning between male and female students, there were significantly different at the .05 level.
5. The attitudes towards learning between male and female students were significantly different at the .05 level, however, education acceptance and teacher approval aspects were not significantly different at the .05 level.
6. In comparison of the attitudes towards profession between male and female students, there were not significantly different at the .05 level.
7. The habits and attitudes towards learning and attitudes towards profession between the students in Bangkok Metropolis and in the other provinces were not significantly different at the .05 level.
