The objectives of this study was to determine general information, knowledge, attitude and behavior concerning HIV infection of female and male prostitues in Phuket Province by interview 351 female and 139 male prostitues from November 1993 and January 1994.

It was found that the average age of female and male prostitues were 24.5 and 22.4 years old respectively. Most of female prostitues had primary level of education, or lower, while most of male prostitues had secondary level of education.

Most of female and male prostitues had a medium range of attitude score. The rate of using condom for female and male prostitues were 88.4% and 75.5% respectively.

It was also found that the level of knowledge of female and male prostitues had significant association with the level of attitude. However, the knowledge and attitude of female prostitues had no association with the behavior of condom usage. The level of knowledge of male prostitues also had no association with behavior, which contrast with the level of attitude (p<0.05)

There were statistically significant different (p>0.001) between female and male prostitues regarding the following factors, age, education, income, marrital status, times being prostitue, attitude score, and behavior of using condom. Nevertheless, there was no difference (p>0.05) in knowledge score and history of venerial disease between the two groups.
