The purposes of this study were as follows;

1. To find the relationship between the factors and the attitude towards environment conservation of prathom suksa six students.
2. To find the factors related to the attitude towards the environment conservation of prathom suksa six students.

The results of the research indicated that :

1. The correlation coefficient between attitude towards environment conservation and all the sixty-six variables concerning students, parents, schools, peer groups, communication, communities and religion indicated that ten variables of seven factors were statistically significant at .01 level. The factors showing positive effects were students' achievement, parents' rearing, receiving of environment conservation information from television, peer groups identification, democratic up-bringing parents' practice and teachers' practice. However communities' activities, autocratic up-bringing and money expense per day showed negative relationship.

2. The nine variables relating to environment attitude were ranked as follows : students' achievement, parents' rearing, receiving of environment conservation information from television, money expense per day, teachers' practice, parents' practice and autocratic up-bringing. Nevertheless communities activities, extra curricular, activities money expense per day, parents' practice and autocratic up-bringing showed negative relationship.
