The purpose of this study was to study life satisfaction of working early adults in Bangkok Metropolis and to study relationship between age and the following variables : sex, marital status, levels of education and incomes towards life satisfaction of working early adults in Bangkok Metropolis. Life satisfaction questionnaires, adapted from Neugarten et al. (1961), were completed by 400 subjects and two-way ANOVA and schaffe' method were used to analyse the data. The results were as follows:

1. Age had no effect on life satisfaction of working early adults in Bangkok Metropolis.
2. A relationship between differences in age and sex was found to effect life satisfaction of working early adults in Bangkok Metropolis at less than .01 level of significance.
3. A relationship between differences in age and marital status had no effect on life satisfaction of working early adults in Bangkok Metropolis.
4. A relationship between differences in age and levels of education had no effect on life satisfaction of working early adults in Bangkok Metropolis. However, people of difference levels of education had different life satisfaction at .01 level of significance.
5. A relationship between differences in age and incomes had no effect on life satisfaction of working early adults in Bangkok Metropolis. However, people of different incomes had different life satisfaction at .01 level of significance.
