The objectives of the thesis, "The Commission of Counter Corruption : A Case Study of Countering the Corruption of Thai Political Appointees," are as follows :

(1) to study the process of controling corruption of Thai political appointees,

(2) to study the effectiveness of the controling structure,

(3) to study the functional efficiency of such body.

The finding confirms the fact that, due to certain difficulties, the Commission is relatively powerless in its dealing with political appointees.

Consequently, if shortcomings are to be rectified, legal, personnel, structural, functional and jurisdictional improvements have to be made.
