The purpose of this thesis is to examine the relationship between legal principles embodied in the German Unification Treaty, and the two Vienna Conventions on Succession of States in respect of Treaties of 1978, and on Succession of States in respect of State Property, Archives and Debts of 1983.

The research findings are : 1) The legal principles embodied in the German Unification Treaty in respect of the Federal Republic of Germany and the German Democratic Republic Treaties are in accordance with the Vienna Convention on Succession of States in respect of Treaties, 1978. However, additional procedures are required for the Federal Republic of Germany as far as her relation with the European Union is concerned. 2) The legal principles in the German Unification Treaty in respect of the German Democratic Republic property and debts are in accordance with the legal principles stipulated in the Vienna Convention on Succession of States in respect of State Property, Archives and Debts, 1983. 3) The Unified Germany is a differs from other cases of Uniting of States in the past because the role of regional organization like the European Union has to be taken into account in considering issue of state succession.
