The objective of this research is to study the psychosocial adjustment of suicical attempters after discharging from Ramathibodi Hospital. Of the 65 suicical patients admitted to Ramathibodi Hospital during January 1, 1991 to December 31, 1992. 35 were available for interviewed. CESD (Center of Epidimiologic Studies-Depression Scale) and Social Adjustment scale were use as the messurement.

The results of this study show that:

- 1. Suicidal attempters after discharging from Ramathibodi Hospital had low level of psychosocial adjustment.
- 2. Psychological adjustment is not significantly correlated to social adjustment at 0.05 level.
- 3. Socially-Expected Activity in Social Adjustment between depressed group and non-depressed group are significantly different at 0.05 level.
