ABSTRACT

The objectives of this research are 1) to investigate socio-economic espects of the non-commission police officers under Police Command Region 4 2) to examine problems and needs of the non-commission police officers about their economic situation and families and 3) to survey proper models to promote secondary occupation of community agriculture through self-reliant of the non-commission police officers by reducing family expenses and utilizing their free time beneficially.

The case studies were composed of the non-commission police officers under Police Command Region 4. The tool used to collect data was questionnairs in discussion with both individuals and groups. The data were analysed using the SPSS/PC⁺ computer program. Statistic value used were percentage, mean, t-test and Wilcoxon Signed Ranks Test.

Results of study

- 1) Socio-economic situation of target group was dramatically ameliorant after putting interaction activities, expecially they posessed more knowledge of how to carry out secondary occupation of community agriculture through self-reliant. This could reduce family expenses and stimulate them to settle group.
- 2) Economic problems of target group were alleviated but requirement to gain more knowledge about secondary occupation of community agricuture through self-reliant was found.
- 3) The appropriate models to promote secondary occupation of community agriculture through self-reliant were required to provide knowledges, ideas and experiences, settle promoting occupation fund as well as create technical and marketing networks including regularly monitoring and evaluation.
