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The purpose of this research were to analyse nursing instructors' roles in military and police nursing colleges, to compare instructors' roles according to type of institutions, length of experience and rank, and to study problems of performing role.

The results of research were :

1. There were 8 aspects of nursing instructors' roles as followed

1) Instruction 2) Control and Student Activity 3) Research and Publication
4) Community Services 5) Nursing Profession 6) Military and Police
7) Administration, and 8) Miscellaneous. The highest performance was the role of instruction, the second was nursing profession and the third was military and police. The role performance which was at the lowest level was research and publication.

2. Nursing instructors at Royal Thai Army, Royal Thai Navy, Royal Thai Airforce and Police Nursing Colleges performed roles differently at .01 and .05 significant level.

3. Nursing instructors who had different length of experience performed roles differently at .01 and .05 significant level.

4. Nursing instructors who had different ranks performed different roles at .01 and .05 level of significance.

5. Problems of role performing were time limited, lack of personnel, textbooks and document, audiovisual aids, budget and insufficient administration.
