CHARNCHAI CHOBTHAMASAKUL : THE DEVELOPMENT OF EVALUATION MODEL
FOR QUALITY OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION PROGRAMS FOR SECONDARY SCHOOLS.

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The purpose of this study was to develop an evaluation model for quality of physical education programs for secondary schools. The study procedures were divided into four steps: (1) determining the factors and score weight of the factors to be evaluated; (2) constructing the evaluation model and manual for evaluating; (3) trying-out for testing its reliability and its discriminatability and also to evaluate the evaluation model; and (4) constructing the norms of physical education programs.

It was found that this evaluation model composed of 6 aspects, 55 factors and 71 items to be evaluated. This evaluation model was feasible and applicable in schools situation. It had its reliability at 0.99 ($r_k = 0.99$) and its discriminating validity was statistically significant at .01 level. The norms of physical education programs were also developed according to the schools sizes.
