

Kornkanok Chamnanpet : A Study of Supervisory Management in Secondary Schools Participating the Academic Supervision Project of the Department of General Education, Educational Region Seven. Thesis Advisor : Assist. Prof. Valairat Boonswasdi:186 pp.

The purpose of this study was to study the supervisory management in secondary schools participating the Academic Supervision Project of the Department of General Education, Educational Region Seven.

Two hundred and thirty-three questionnaires were sent to the academic committee of twenty-one secondary schools. Two hundred and eleven questionnaires or 90.56 percent were returned and then the data were analyzed by using percentage.

#### Finding

1. Instructional Organization Task. Schools developed curriculum, vocational courses and elective courses by considering the schools' facilities. By giving more information and knowledge about making and keeping instructional medias were discussion for each department or co-operating among teachers. By giving more information and knowledge to select the instructional activities and techniques, measurements and evaluations were distributing bulletins and arranging the workshops. Problems of instructional organization task were : not using the finding from research to develop instructional task, lack of standardize tests, students did not participate in the student activities programmes, remedial teaching and re-examination.

2. Instructional Supporting Task. Schools had the orientation programmes for staff members, improved academic and professional knowledge, develop public relation, survey situations and need assessments in using instructional medias, and developed the quality of building and materials. Problems of instructional supporting task were : schools could not support the in-service programmes for teachers, vocational courses for the community, and also lack of librarians and counselors.
