

NONGPANGA PRUGPICHAILERS : INTERNATIONAL LEGAL REGIME OF THAI-US.  
TEXTILE TRADE : LESSON FOR THAILAND'S POLICY FORMULATION AND TRADE

This study is aimed at how the legal regime affects the textile trade, what type of problem would arise and how the problem distorts the policy making and trade negotiation of Thailand.

The research shows that the legal regime of textile trade takes the nature of both multilateral agreement and bilateral agreement combined with domestic laws and certain measures of importing countries. These agreement and measures have impact on textile trades.

As to the policy and negotiation of Thailand, the research shows that there is a need of political strategy and foreign policy which corresponds to economic plan, together with the cooperation between public and private sectors. The multilateral negotiation under GATT in one way to solve the problem and increase the bargaining power to Thailand. All solutions should be proceeded in accordance with multilateral and bilateral negotiation and under circumstances that will bring the utmost benefits to the country. At the same time, the negotiation must be carried out at high efficiency and with readiness in term of policy making and arrangement of active entity including the coordination between public and private sectors.
